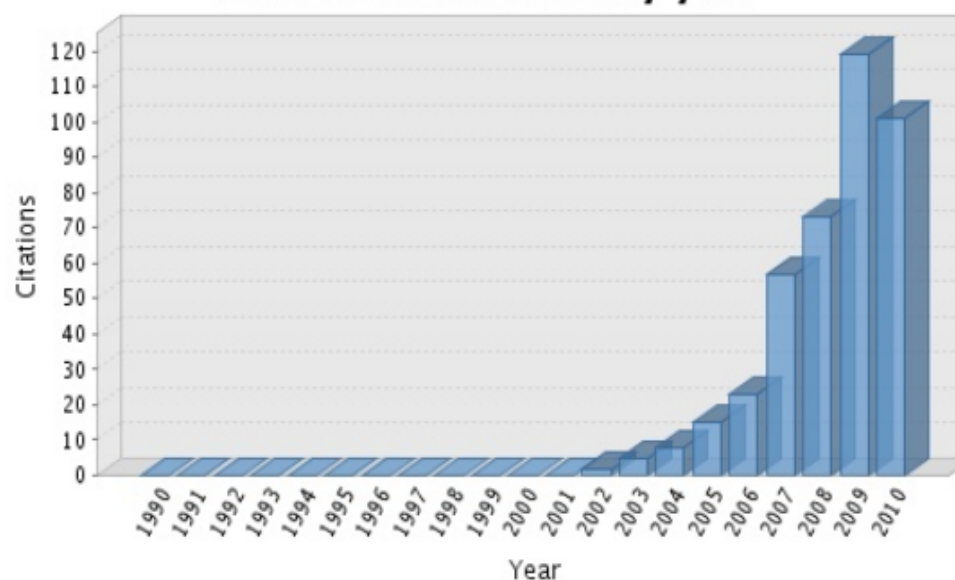

Prof. Hermann A. Haus is a principal investigator in the [Optics and Devices group](#) of the Research Laboratory of Electronics.


Professor Haus' research focuses on advancing the technology of ultrashort pulse laser sources at high repetition rates. Research has made use of a Kerr-lens modelocked Ti:sapphire laser and newly improved double-charged mirrors. Possible further improvements are being investigated through computer simulations of the modelocking operation. Other investigations include attempts to observe soliton squeezing and investigation into large-scale integration using resonant channel dropping filters and ring resonators.

Professor Haus also studies stretched pulse propagation, a new method for improved long-distance data transfer across optical cables, an improved and lower-cost gyroscope source using a passively modelocked erbium-doped fiber laser, improved methods for analyzing bit error rates in optical digital communication, and development of high-Q-value glass microsphere resonators.
